Dear Parents and carers,

Welcome back after the summer break. It was wonderful to see all the children back in the classroom last week and we have had a super start to the term. I have included some important information for this term below for your reference.

#### Reading

We have sent reading books home with children this week and would like to encourage you to read with your children at least three times a week at home. Please record their reading in their reading records. If you need any support with this, please email or speak to me after school.

#### Homework

The children have requested maths homework so I will be sending times tables sheets to practice and complete at home. When a completed sheet is returned a new sheet will be sent home. The expectation is that one sheet is completed weekly at home. Children will focus on one times table until they have mastered it and then progress to a new one. This will also support Year 4 children with their Multiplication Check in the Summer term. Children will also have access to Times Table Rock Stars which we encourage them to use at home to. Log-ins will be placed in the front of the reading records.

#### Timetables

Please see below the outline class timetable for Autumn term (This may change to suit the needs of lessons from time to time) and the topics that we will be covering. We have already started our History topic on the Romans which the Children were very excited about, last week.

#### PE

Our **PE days** will normally be on a **Wednesday** and **Friday** afternoons.
